

Casey Holmes Jr. Memorial Entrance Bursary

2021 Application

Purpose:

Casey Holmes Jr. was a member of the Upper Nicola Indian Band, one of the eight-member Band communities of the Syilx/Okanagan Nation Alliance. He graduated from NVIT's Environmental Resources Technology Diploma Program in 2004. Casey Jr.'s experience, both personally and professionally, shaped his knowledge of and connection to the land. He had a great love for the outdoors and embraced the 'spirit' of the land in his everyday life. He knew the importance of staying connected to the land and understood the reciprocal relationship one should have with it. Casey Jr. was an advocate for sustainable use of the land and resources for future generations.

Eligibility:

Awarded to a graduate of the ENRT Certificate program who plans to complete the ENRT Diploma program. The student must be registered in full-time coursework in the diploma program and must have obtained a minimum 2.33 (C+) grade point average in the Certificate Program. The student must demonstrate financial need, dedication to their studies and connection to the land.

Value:

Each year, the Holmes family will donate one (1) award of \$500 to be distributed at the annual NVIT awards ceremony. The bursary will be applied to the student's account as it is to be used for tuition, books or supplies.

Process:

Students must complete the following application checklist:

- Complete and sign the application form.
- Fill out the budget information sheet.
- In a sealed envelope, have an NVIT instructor submit, a character reference letter describing the applicant's consistent commitment and responsibility toward his/her studies.
- In a sealed envelope, have an external community member submit a character reference letter describing the applicant's strong positive personal attributes, independent manner and strong leadership skills.
- Write a double-spaced, 500-word essay on, "How you are connected and have a relationship with the land". (The essay must be written to the family of Casey Holmes Jr. as the intended audience.)

Deadline:

The NVIT Registration Office must receive applications by 4:30pm on August 15th. If August 15th lands on a weekend, the application will be due on the last business day **before** the deadline. Late or Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Please mail or drop off original copies only; faxes, emails and/or photocopies will not be accepted. Students may appeal the award decision by submitting a written letter to the awards adjudication committee attention:
