

# CIBC Leadership Bursary

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## Purpose:

CIBC is committed to supporting organizations assisting Canadians in need by encouraging leadership, civic engagement and independent living; celebrating the diversity of our communities and encouraging the volunteer spirit of our employees. In addition, CIBC invests in community programs to support skills development, including financial literacy and employment opportunities, access to community services, equality and diversity.

## Eligibility:

The CIBC Leadership Bursary is awarded to two full-time students, from any campus, registered in minimum 80% course loads in any of the following programs: Health Care Assistant Certificate, Chemical Addiction Worker Certificate and Diploma, Access to Practical Nursing Diploma, Aboriginal Early Childhood Education Certificate and Diploma, Law Enforcement Preparation Certificate, Administrative Studies Certificate and Diploma, and the Associate of ARTS Degrees. Students must have achieved minimum 3.0 grade point averages, demonstrate financial need and describe their leadership skills and community engagement.

## Value:

\$500 x 2

Each year, CIBC will disburse two (2) \$500, CIBC Leadership Bursaries at the annual NVIT Awards Ceremony.

## Process:

Students must complete the following application process. Complete this checklist:

- Complete and sign the application form.
- Submit an NVIT transcript for the current academic year.
- Complete the enclosed budget information.
- Have a community member submit, in a sealed envelope, a character reference letter describing the student's leadership skills and citizenship qualities.
- Submit a 300-500 word essay outlining the students' engagement and community involvement within their communities and the NVIT community.

## Deadline:

The deadline to submit the application for the CIBC Leadership Bursary is April 30<sup>th</sup>, by 4:30pm to the Registrar's Office. Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Students may appeal the award decision by submitting a written letter to the awards adjudication committee attention:
