NVIT Students Update – March 12, 2021

Earlier this week, the Provincial Health Officer, Dr. Bonnie Henry, provided information for B.C. public post-secondary institutions to guide planning for returning to face-to-face classes this Fall 2021. The Provincial Health Office indicated that current projections of the COVID-19 vaccine supply in B.C. suggest that everyone eligible, that wants to receive a vaccination will be able to by mid-summer. NVIT's Leadership Team will be updating their COVID-19 Safety Plan that will be informed by the new Go-Forward Guidelines, provided by the Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Training
